The competition is open to all youth, junior high, high school, and college cheer and dance teams. The Devil's Dare will be held in **Detrick Gymnasium**, located in **Kaiser Hall** on the campus of Central Connecticut State University. The competition will be in the late morning with registration check-in tentatively scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m.

Team Fee - \$175.00 (All divisions)

*Dance – There is a \$50 fee per additional dance category

CHEER AND DANCE DIVISIONS:

<u>PEE WEE</u> - Open to teams 4th grade and under
<u>YOUTH</u> - Open to teams 6th grade and under
<u>JUNIOR HIGH</u> - Open to all junior high school teams, 8th grade and under
<u>ALL-GIRL JUNIOR VARSITY</u> - Open to JV teams only with NO male Members
<u>CO-ED JUNIOR VARSITY</u> - Open to JV teams with one or more male members
<u>ALL-GIRL VARSITY</u> - Open to all high school teams who are made up of all girls
<u>CO-ED VARSITY</u> - Open to all high school teams with one or more male members
<u>COLLEGE</u> - Open to any college team (All Girl & Co-Ed Divisions)

Scoresheets will be broken up into categories following the CT States Scoresheets. Four panel judges will each be scoring one category. A safety judge and penalty judge will be present as well.

Admission is \$10 per person. Children 5 and under are admitted free of charge.

FURTHER EVENT INFORMATION

Pee Wee and **Youth** teams are expected to follow safety guidelines put forth by their local, state, or national cheerleading organization.

All **high school** teams must adhere to the 2019-2020 National Federation Spirit Rules. NFHS guidelines may be downloaded at www.nfhs.com under the Spirit listing. All high school routines must contain a voice (cheer) portion.

College Teams must follow the safety guidelines set forth by the AACCA and NCAA. College routines may be performed entirely to music or music and a non-music cheer portion. AACCA guidelines may be downloaded at www.aacca.org.

ALL MATERIAL MUST BE SUITABLE FOR FAMILY VIEWING.

All high school cheer teams will be competing in Detrick Gymnasium, located in Kaiser Hall, on a 42'x 42' **non-spring** floor (7 strips). College teams will compete on a 54' x 42' non-spring floor. All dance teams will be competing on a hardwood floor – all footwear must have non-marking soles.

NO stunting or tumbling is allowed outside of designated warm-up or performance areas.

The practice mat will be a standard 42' x 42' cheerleading mat for high school teams and 54' x 42' mat for college teams.

Registration Check-In is **tentatively** set to begin at **10:00 a.m.**

Music for High School Cheer Routines: The time limit of each routine is 2:30 but there will not be a restriction to the amount of music you can have in your routine. There is still a voice/motions category on the score sheet -- your cheerleaders must use their voices for some portion of your routine.

Attention Coaches: Only 2 coaches will be admitted free of charge. Any additional coaches must pay the admission fee.

All participants must complete and submit the Liability Release form (may be submitted on day of competition) in order to compete.
